BY-LAWS ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1. MEMBERSHIP: Shall consist of active and honorary memberships. 11/89

SECTION 2. ACTIVE MEMBERS: Anyone twenty-one of age or older shall be eligible to this class of membership. A member shall be an individual male or female or a married couple. All shall be entitled to all the privileges of the club including the right to vote and hold office. In the case of a married couple they shall have collectively one (1) vote be it either at an executive board meeting or at a general membership meeting. A married couple may at any time elect to hold two (2) memberships by applying according to the requirement of Section 4 of these By-Laws. No initiation fee would apply in this case. Each paying membership shall have an interest in the club, based on the number of paying memberships for a particular year, in the case of dissolution of the club.

The members of the active class shall be limited in number as determined by the Executive Committee to four hundred (400) class "A" members. 11/98

SECTION 3. HONORARY MEMBERSHIP: The Executive Committee may, at any time, recommend to the Club, at any meeting, any person who, in the judgment of the Committee, is entitled to be honored by the membership in the Club. An honorary member shall not shall not hold office or have the right to vote.

SECTION 4. MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: Any person wishing to join the Club shall be proposed and seconded by a member of the Club in good standing. The applicant shall be presented in person to the Executive Committee at a regular Executive Committee meeting by either the proposer or the second member signing the application. After meeting with the Executive Committee and completing any other membership requirements specified in these By-Laws, the Executive Committee will then vote on the application of the proposed member. If accepted, the club membership will be notified of the new member's election in the next newsletter and the member will be mailed a letter of acceptance along with his or her membership card. The applicant's membership becomes effective at the next Executive Committee meeting. 10/06

SECTION 4a. A membership application shall not be considered unless accompanied by a check in the amount specified by Article VII, Section 1. If the application is rejected, the amount submitted shall be refunded.

SECTION 4b. The Executive Committee shall elect an applicant by at least two-thirds vote of the members present or by voting by proxy. 1998

SECTION 4c. A new member will be expected to contribute to the operation of the Club, to familiarize him or herself with the Club rules, members and policies and to assist at Club events as requested by the event Chairman.

SECTION 4d. An applicant accepted after September 30th, who has met the requirements of Section 4a, will be considered paid up until December 31st of the following year. Such new members may enjoy all the privileges of the Club except that he or she will not be eligible for an award in the current year's fishing contests.

SECTION 4e. A new member shall not be eligible to vote in an election of the Club until he or she shall have been a member for 60 days. The minutes of the Executive Committee shall be conclusive evidence of such eligibility.

SECTION 4f. At the Executive Committee meeting during which an applicant is presented, the above Article VI, Section 4 thru Section 4f, shall be presented to the proposed member.
